CLASSROOM POLICIES

Class Etiquette

- All classes begin and end at their given times. Students who arrive up to 10 minutes late should come in quietly and quickly catch up. Dancers who are 10 or more minutes ***late to class cannot participate*** but should come into the studio and observe the remainder of their class.
- Parents, guardians and families are asked to ***please wait quietly*** while they wait for their child to finish class. Active children and loud voices easily disrupt our classes.
- ***Early arrivals*** are welcome and reminded that often a class is taking place directly ahead of theirs and are asked to remain quiet and respectful of those dancers already in class.
- All dancers are required to ***wear a leotard and tights*** with hair pulled back neatly and securely. Ballet students are required to wear ballet shoes. Modern students will be dancing barefoot or in thin socks. Shorts, tee shirts, and non-form fitting clothing are unacceptable for dance classes at Moving Arts.
- If a dancer has ***an injury*** and is unable to dance, they are encouraged to come and watch their class on that day.
- ***Sick dancers*** are asked to stay home until they are well.

Absences

- If a dancer has to miss a class, ***please be sure to call*** Moving Arts. There are no make-up classes for students who miss a dance class. There are arrangements for make-up classes if Moving Arts cancels a class due to teacher's illness.
- ***Private lesson students*** needing to cancel class must do so with at least 48 hours notice. A fee of \$30 will be charged for cancellations within 48 hours previous to the lesson.
